<p>EMERGENCY POWERS given to Roosevelt</p>	
<p>One of the first acts was the EMERGENCY BANKING ACT persuading people to put their money back into banks.</p>	
<p>ALPHABET AGENCIES were set up.</p>	
<p>Radio broadcasts were from the Whitehouse to reassure the people these were called 'FIRESIDE CHATS'</p>	
<p>Roosevelt explained his policies and this helped to RESTORE CONFIDENCE.</p>	
<p>Roosevelt earned trust of the people.</p>
